

The American Sewing Guild Corpus Christi Chapter Scholarship

The Corpus Christi Chapter of the American Sewing Guild Scholarship is designed to provide educational opportunities in the form of a scholarship for College students from and High School Seniors in Corpus Christi and the surrounding area interested in sewing related fields.

Eligibility Requirements for High School Students –

- Graduate of the class of 2009.
- Plan to attend a major college, university, or vocational technical school to study in a sewing related field.
- Live and attend high school in Corpus Christi or the surrounding area.

Eligibility Requirements for College Students –

- Be enrolled in a major college, university, or vocational technical school and majoring in a sewing related field.
- Attended high school in Corpus Christi or the surrounding area.

Application –

- Complete the attached application form and attach photo
- Transcript of high school/college grades (College students must also provide proof you are from Corpus Christi or the surrounding area. A high school transcript or copy of Texas DL with area address will suffice.)
- Two letters of recommendation (other than family)
- Personal Narrative – write and attach a narrative, not more than one page in length, about yourself, pointing out any important facts you would like the selections committee to know. (Do not repeat information already stated in the application.)

Process –

- Application must be submitted to The American Sewing Guild – Corpus Christi Chapter on or before June 30, 2009.
- Applications will be judged by the American Sewing Guild – Corpus Christi Chapter Scholarship committee.
- Recipient will be selected based on scholastic achievement, character, community involvement, leadership and financial need.

Payment –

- Payment of scholarship funds will be made to the college, university, or technical school at the beginning of the fall semester once verification of enrollment has been made.
